Good Shepherd Anglican Church in Edmonton is looking for a Vacation Bible School Leader. It's 3-4 weeks of paid work to run our Vacation Bible School. Camp runs August 26-30 from 8-4pm Monday to Friday with a Thursday overnight.

We need an organized, charismatic leader who can adapt to changing circumstances and is good with kids and adult volunteers alike. You will be supported by our rector and an experienced team of volunteers. Last year's camp was "Dare to be Different" based on the book and film *A Wrinkle in Time* and God's love that spans the universe. We had about 25 awesome kids and 12 adult volunteers.

We need you to:

- Organize the schedule, research and help choose an awesome curriculum,
- Develop activities and games to keep the kids moving and help them remember our key points.
- Be proactive in creating a safe and inclusive environment and minimizing risks to our staff, volunteers, Leaders-in-training, and campers.

Must be able to pass a criminal and vulnerable sector record check. References are required and will be contacted. This is a contract position, remuneration will be based on experience \$18-\$22/hour. The first 2-3 weeks will be scheduled 5-8 hours per week for planning, supply purchases, etc. The week of camp runs 8-4, M-F with a Thursday overnight.

Most importantly, the kids need to walk away from their time with us knowing that God loves them and church is a fun place with loving people.
